VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

The ***Northern Burlington Domestic Violence Response Team***, in collaboration with the ***Mansfield Twp Police Department & Providence House***, is seeking Volunteers to serve victims of domestic violence in ***Mansfield, Chesterfield, North Hanover, Bordentown, Bordentown City, and Springfield.***

Volunteers will receive training (40 hrs. conducted over an 8 week period) to assist victims of Domestic Violence in a variety of ways, ultimately providing support and information to help them make informed decisions about the options available to them.

Applicants must be:

- ◆ 18 yrs. of age or older
- ◆ Resident of, or employed in the Burlington County area
- ◆ Valid N. J. Drivers license
- ◆ Available transportation
- ◆ No criminal history
- ◆ No prior history as a defendant in a domestic violence related matter
- ◆ Available to be on call a minimum of four times per month
- ◆ Ability to communicate well with others
- ◆ Good listener
- ◆ Sensitivity to victims' feelings and concerns
- ◆ Desire to help others
- ◆ Available to participate in initial and ongoing domestic violence training program
